This offers a much more interactive experience than using a standard whiteboard.

As a parent, you are giving your child a life-long advantage by exposing them to a foreign language at an early age. Besides providing a head start for their future language learning, they benefit from a proven boost in scholastic performance in other subject areas.

We offer **quality teaching** promoting excellence with dynamic method of teaching French and recognized **high quality programs** which will guarantee to your child good opportunities for further studies and to obtain diplomas. When taking classes of French at Alliance Française de Vancouver, your child gets access to contents and objectives which lead to the DELF examination. DELF certification qualifies for external credits and Advance Placement under the BC Ministry of Education (grades 10 to 12).

The scholars program seeks well-rounded students who demonstrate character, promise of leadership and strong commitment to service in the community. In 2021, the Alliance Française scholars program will offer up to **20 awards** at the following level:


Student 11 years old and older awards: Up to 1 year of French classes (September 2021 to August 2022, including Summer programs)

French, as an official language of Canada, has a very special position in the school system, be in core French programs, intensive French, Immersion classes, and francophones programs.

The new programs and examinations in BC organized around the **DELF** are in the line of the methodology we have developed for years in Alliance Française for your kids' French classes: task-based approach, communicative skills, and linguistic objectives. Our courses are a **great asset** for youths studying French. DELF allows to get external credits.

Our program for French classes are based on the latest textbooks and methodologies, like the **Adosphère** method, édition Hachette FLE. It fosters participation and provides the student with a range of **written and spoken skills** to communicate in various situations. Students learn to speak, read and write in French using a great variety of oral and written material.

At the end of each session of French class, students will be tested and will receive a **certificate of achievement**.

Alliance Française Scholars are chosen for their strong interest in the French language, service and leadership potential. They deeply value integrity and honesty, show passion for French and are interested in cultural diversity. Furthermore, they are willing to take meaningful risks and strive for results. Each Alliance Française Scholar shows a sustained commitment to service in the community, has taken the initiative to create positive changes and is interested in working for a better world.

Eligibility criteria for students:

- Present a minimum cumulative average of 80%
- Hold Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status
- Must be 11 years of age or older as of September 1st, 2021
- Must be less than 18 years old

- Print, complete and send the application at dhubert@alliancefrancaise.ca before June 1st, 2021. (if you have the latest verison of Adobe Acrobat, you should be able to complete the application before printing it)
- As part of the online application, tell us whether you are seeking support from your principal, guidance counselor, teacher or school administrator. Each school may support up to five candidates.
- You will need to request a reference from a teacher, community member or someone else who is familiar with your activities. The reference may not be a family member or friend.

Note: Reference letters and sponsorship confirmation must be complete by the application deadline. Ensure your reference writer and sponsors are aware of the date.
