

CULTURAL PROGRAMS

The financial contributions received in 2022 helped us present 99 online and in-person events, of which our most prominent projects were:

ESPACE V - V-UNFRAMED

In 2022, the 2nd edition of V-Unframed took place, with over 13 digital art exhibitions of local an international artists. With a sold-out event, our virtual platform Espace V is reaching a larger audience and promoting culture in an innovative way.

FÊTE DE LA MUSIQUE

On the occasion of Fête de la Musique, a series of concerts from professional and amateur musicians took place in Vancouver. A large number of attendees got to enjoy and dance in a welcoming environment!

IL ÉTAIT UNE FOIS VANCOUVER

In 2022, "Il était une fois Vancouver," continued with its monthly theatrical storytelling free of charge to families in the Greater Vancouver area. Each month, different francophone artists shared their talent with families, contributing to the enrichment of the French language and francophone cultures.







CAPITAL INVESTMENTS

Funding received in 2022 helped us with the following capital investments:

CULTURAL SPACES

\$384,000 in funds provided by Canadian Heritage are being directed toward our new art gallery and theatre.

The Province of BC through the BC Art Council provided \$175,000 in funds that will be directed towards the equipment of our theatre.

COMMUNITY SPACES

\$925,000 provided by Canadian Heritage and \$750,000 provided by PacifiCan are being directed toward our new community spaces such as our future Media Library, Demonstration Kitchen and our community spaces.
