With over 120 years of experience, we bring cultural immersion, hands-on learning, and bilingual expertise to every program. Our workshops are designed to be educational, and fun for your students.



Students follow simple French recipes to create delicious pastries, learning language and culture through culinary activities, while practicing active listening.



Students watch a French film in our professional theater and engage in a guided discussion to develop listening, comprehension, and cultural awareness. English subtitles are provided.



Students watch the beginning of a video and step into the role of playwrights, creating and performing the rest of the story as a short play while practicing parts of speech and anticipating the plot.



Pedagogical Support for Teachers

- How long do the workshops/shows last?
