2025: A YEAR OF ANCHORING AND TRANSFORMATION

In Vancouver, eighteen months after moving into our new building, Alliance Française Vancouver has fully entered a new era. This space has become much more than a cultural venue: **it is now a true vibrant community hub, open to the public every day.**



Since 2025, our relationship with Alliance Française de Victoria has now established the **Alliance Française Canada Pacific (AFCP)**. This union strengthens our reach and impact across the province, allowing us to expand collaborations, broaden our services, and respond more effectively to **the needs of a rapidly growing community.**

Our renewed and deliberately multidisciplinary programming has found new audiences. In Vancouver, events such as *Les Épicuriens*, *Le RDV des Familles*, and *Le Petit Théâtre* are consistently sold out, reflecting strong public engagement.

We are also continuing our efforts to **welcome and engage school groups**, with 19 CSF schools, 5 immersion schools, and 21 classes from other private schools, participating in 2025.

As part of our efforts to foster collaboration and diversification, the Alliance Française Victoria is following this model and is also launching new events for its community, such as *Les Epicuriens*.

Across the province, Francophone and artistic life is thriving thanks to cultural, educational, and community activities, underscoring the central role that AFCP plays in the local cultural landscape.

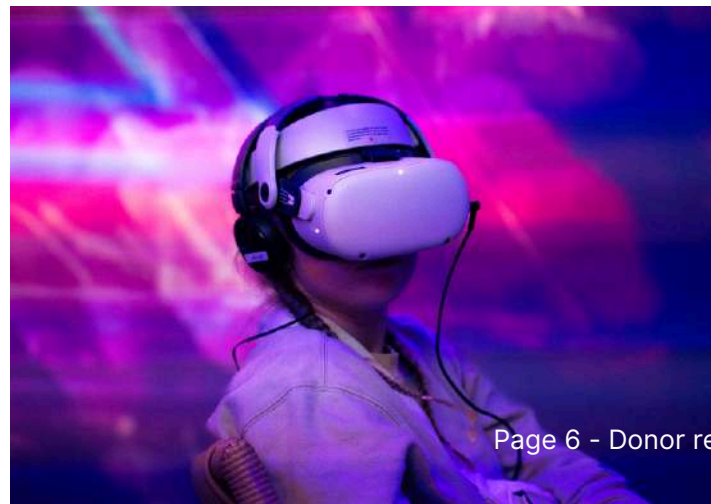
2025: OPENING OF ARTIST STUDIOS NEW CREATIVE SPACES

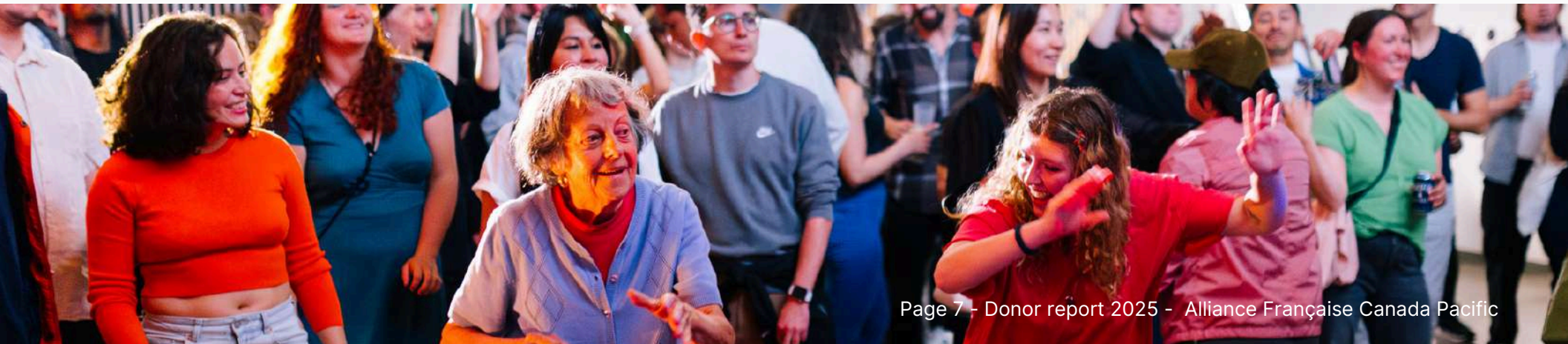
